

Now, today, we're going to have a look at the use of the expression "du coup" in French.

This is a really common informal expression.

"Du coup" is spelt DU COUP and it just means "so"

For example, it was raining, so I took my umbrella

Il pleuvait, du coup, j'ai pris mon parapluie

It's usually used quite informally in conversation.

Another example

I forgot my credit card, so I paid in cash

J'ai oublié ma carte de crédit, donc j'ai payé en liquide

or j'ai oublié ma carte de crédit, du coup, j'ai payé en liquide

So, it's just an informal way of saying "in consequence" or so.
